Dear friends of Artistic Dance!

The first WADF World Championships, held in Liberec, Czech Republic are now behind us and were a tremendous success. Competitors from 12 countries competed in a friendly atmosphere filled with positive energy with over 1000 dancers competing in 271 events. Many dancers participated in many events and disciplines totalling over 5000 entries.

The Championships were held over 5 days starting early in the morning, finishing late at night. High quality performances with excellent technique made the evaluations for 36 judges extra hard to find all the winners.

The Czech Republic was represented by the largest delegation of more than 50 dance schools. Around 200 dancers made the journey from Russia to form the second largest delegation. Other countries represented by dancers were France, Hungary, Italy, Poland and Ukraine.

The managing Committee were delighted with the number of new faces from other countries who had come to Liberec just to watch. Before they left for home five new countries applied for membership. The WADF has certainly made its presence known in the dancing world with these first official World Championships of Artistic Dance.

Many new ideas were born which will result in more disciplines being included in the WADF programme. Many Dance School owners have requested an International 10-Dance division for the Standard (Ballroom) and Latin American disciplines, which under the WADF structure will result in more events being made available to their pupils than are possible with the traditional federations.


The introduction of Artistic Solo, Duo and Teams provides these Dance Schools with a wider range of opportunities for their pupils to study and practice for.

Events coming up


The nest large official WADF Open event will be held in March 2014, in Moscow. It is to be the 2014 Couple Dance Division Open European Championships, including Solos, Duos, Trios, Small and Large Teams in all Caribbean style dance, plus all the Standard (Ballroom) and Latin American dances. Additionally we are looking forward to One Dance competitions in special couple dances like, Argentine Tango, Disco Fox, Jitterbug and more.

There two other important events to announce for April 2014.

First in Novi Sad, Serbia, the 2014 World Stage Dance Championships, in the divisions of Jazz Dance, Contemporary Ballet and Scenic Dance Show. We are also looking forward to the 2014 European Urban Street and Urban Street Show Championships in some of the Urban Street dance disciplines.

Secondly in Estonia the WADF is planning to present the 2014 Open European Street Dance Championships with Urban Pop and some Urban Street dance disciplines, all of which will be included in the Baltic Cup presented and organised by our member Triina Utt. Dancers from Central and Southern European Europe are expected to dance alongside dancers from Scandinavian countries and St. Petersburg, Russia. These ingredients will make up a fantastic WADF event in the Baltic region. This event is not yet confirmed.

An Open to the World Turkish Championship is also on the table, to be held during the summer months, in a pleasant coastal hotel, in one of Turkey's exciting seaside resorts. Workshops and Seminars will also be arranged in connection with this event. More details will be displayed in our Calendar.
