Dear Members and Friends of Artistic Dance!. The WADF European Street and Pop Dance Division Championships were held in a thrilling atmosphere in the Large Kalevi Sport Hall, Tallinn, Estonia.

With more than 2000 enrolments, 916 individual dancers competing over two days, guaranteed a fantastic atmosphere and intensive dancing. The organiser, Mrs. Triina Utt, and her experienced team did an amazing job comforting the dancers, officials, parents and relatives from 8 countries.

The event was a joint presentation of the WADF European Championships and the 9th Baltic Cup. The competitors participated in Urban Street, Urban Pop and Urban Street Show dance competitions, which were part of the European Championships. We also saw Slow Disco, House and Hip Hop competitions which has resulted in our Street and Pop Dance Division being enlarged by 3 new disciplines; Urban House, Urban Locking & Popping and Acrobatic Jazz Funk.

During the day before the Championships we were pleased to hold another WADF International Adjudicator Seminar, with Examination. A report follows on page 6 in this ADN issue. We are delighted to welcome 12 new WADF International Adjudicators into our WADF family, which still leaves room for many more.

We are now focusing on the WADF World Stage Dance Division Championships to be held in Novi Sad, Serbia, 7th – 8th June. We are expecting dancers from 10/11 countries and because it is the 1st WADF Stage Dance event expectations are high on head organiser, Mrs. Gordana Orescanin. Everyone will be very welcome!

WADF European Street Dance Division Championships

The 1st WADF Street and Pop Dance competition was held in Tallinn, Estonia on 12th-13th April. Statistics of 2054 entries of 651 Solos, 129 Duos and 136 Small and Large Teams show that we can proudly call this event a success.

The largest contingent came from Belarus with around 250 dancers, while others came from Finland, Latvia, Lithuania and Russia to join the Estonia dancers.

It was wonderful to witness the very high standard, especially the thrilling finals of the Male Adult Urban Street Solo and Female Urban Pop Dance Solo, which were of an exceptional high quality. During the Baltic Cup we watched interesting disciplines like House and Slow Disco with stunning Acrobatic moves, which the WADF will add to its large roster of disciplines.

As a test we assessed all finals with the unique WADF 2-dimentional judging system, which worked perfectly to our satisfaction. Here I wish to acknowledge the efficiency of the father and daughter scrutineer team, Agu and Käthlin Riis, who we welcome as recognised WADF scrutineers.

This year's Baltic Cup has set a bench mark for the standard and success we can look forward to in Tallinn for the years ahead, when it will be possible for WADF dancers from many more countries to take part. It is predicted that the WADF Street, Break and Pop Dance division has a very bright future with as the street dances are very much alive and fruitful in Dance School and the Street Community around the world.
